

DISCLOSURE OF CHANGE IN TEACHER'S CRIMINAL HISTORY

Under section 68 of the *Education (Queensland College of Teachers) Act 2005* ("the Act"), if there is a change in an approved teacher's criminal history, the teacher must immediately disclose to the College the details of the change. The maximum penalty for failure to do so is 100 penalty units (currently equivalent to \$7500). For an approved teacher who does not have a criminal history, there is taken to be a change in the teacher's criminal history if the teacher acquires a criminal history. Section 69 of the Act states that the disclosure must be in the approved form.
